7 weeks	Pentacel #1 Pprevnar #1 Rotateq #1	Pentacel = DTaP, IPV (Polio), HiB combination DTaP = Diphtheria, Tetanus, Pertussis HiB = antibacterial, Pprevnar = antibacterial Rotateq = oral vaccine against rotavirus (cause of serious gastroenteritis in infants), Edinburgh depression screening and Ages & Stages development screening
3 months	Hep B #2	Survey of well being
4 months	Pentacel #2 Pprevnar #2 Rotateq #2	Ages & Stages development screening
6 months	Pentacel #3 Pprevnar #3 Rotateq #3	Ages & Stages development screening
9 months	Hep B #3 Hgb/Lead	Hgb = test for anemia Ages & Stages development screening
12 months	Hepatitis A #1 VZV #1 MMR #1	Hep A is food/water borne type of virus VZV = Chicken Pox MMR = measles, mumps, rubella Ages & Stages development screening
15 months	Pprevnar #4 HIB #4	Ages & Stages development screening
18 months	Hep A#2 DTaP #4	Administer M-CHAT development screening Ages & Stages development screening
2 years	Hgb/Lead	Administer M-CHAT development screening Ages & Stages development screening
4 years	DTaP #5 IPV #4	PSC-17 development screening
5 years	MMR #2 VZV #2 HGB	PSC-17 development screening Hgb = test for anemia
6-10 years		PSC-17 development screening
11-12 years	Tdap MenQuadfi #1 Gardasil 1/2/3	Tdap = Tetanus, diphtheria, pertussis, MenACWY Menactra = meningococcal meningitis protection PSC-17 development screening Gardasil = HPV Virus protection (STD/Cancer) PHQ-9 modified for adolescents screening
13-15 years		PHQ-9 modified for adolescents screening
16 years	MenQuadfi #2 Any catch-up Vaccines	PHQ-9 modified for adolescents screening
Ages 6 months-18 years	Flu Vaccine yearly September-March	Given at well visits or separate flu vaccine appointment
Pre College	Bexsero 1&2	Meningococcal meningitis B PHQ-9
